### "I had lost everything" - John's story

John was his wife's carer - living in a council owned and adapted home. Sadly she committed suicide, everything became too much and John then made several attempts to end his own life. Whilst in hospital their home was repossessed and all Johns' belongings holding the memories of his life and marriage of 20 years were lost. His benefit payments stopped, he was both homeless and without the means to provide for himself. Pye Green Christian Centre and the Cannock and District foodbank were able to help John to regain his benefit payments, providing a room in supported housing and food parcels until he had an income John needs time to grieve for his wife, and has problems to resolve but the support that the Pye Green Christian Centre and Cannock and District foodbank were able to give was vital.
